They regularly conduct classes in reloading and firearm safety.

Dave is an expert in reloading/handloading. He reloads over 300 rifle calibers and uses almost all of Forster's reloading tools.

In 2007, he won gold as a firing member of the World Champion U21 USA Young Eagles. He also won the 2009 Canadian Target Rifle Championship and finished in first place in seven other competitions and won the NW International Prone Championship and WA State 600 Yard Prone Championship.

In 2010, Bachand appeared in the first season of History Channel's marksmen competition *Top Shot*. He appeared in 2012 as an expert during one episode of the fourth season of *Top Shot*, coaching the contestants in how to shoot particularly long shots and returned again in 2013 for the fifth season's All Star Competition. *Top Shot* can be viewed on Amazon Prime Video.

He finished in the Top 10 at the United States LR Nationals, Fullbore Nationals, and 3rd Palma Individual Trophy Match in 2010.

Kelly was on the coaching staff for the 2011 USA Young Eagles Rifle Team on their trip to the World Long Range Championships in Brisbane, Australia and was also a shooter on the US Palma Team on the same trip. Bachand shot in the World Long Range Championships in both the Open and Under-25 categories. In the Open category he finished 29th in the world and in the Under-25 category he finished second.

Kelly Bachand received the U.S. Rifle Team International Distinguished Rifleman Badge. He is badge #29.

Stuart is proud to say that he's one of the people who started International Rimfire Benchrest (IRB) and also introduced 1000 yard Benchrest shooting competition to Australia in 1998 at the Canberra Rifle Club.

Both Stuart and Annie qualified for the Australian Benchrest Hall of Fame in two different championship styles of rifle shooting. Together, they shoot every possible form of Benchrest from the original, traditional group shooting events to Hunterclass score shooting, to Long Range with 500m and 1,000 yard BR plus Rimfire and F Class.

Stuart was a member of the title winning Australia A team at the 2016 World Rimfire Championships for Benchrest rifle shooting in Portugal. With that win, he achieved a personal goal – to become the first person to win gold at both the World Centrefire Championships (group shooting) and at the World Rimfire Championships (score shooting).



Rich Machholz

Rich Machholz is currently retired from having been a member of the Sierra Bullets staff since 1992. He reloads more than two dozen calibers and uses them all. His areas of expertise include centerfire rifles, reloading, load development and data accumulation for centerfire rifles, and long range benchrest competition.

A resident of Marshall, MO, Rich has a varied background, including several types of hunting. His greatest passion is benchrest shooting with an emphasis on the medium and long distances; a venue where Rich has excelled.

Rich's first experience with Forster's quality reloading products was with the Forster Products Case Trimmer, which he still uses with a variety of accessories including the Outside Neck Turner.
