92 L.A. Wildlands, a new line of lever-action rifles blending classic features in a dynamic and modern design

Chiappa Firearms announces the launch of a new line of lever-action rifles to expand their well-known 1892 series: the Chiappa 92 L.A. Wildlands lever-action rifles offer a great blend of tradition and innovation, in a package chambered for the powerful yet controllable and versatile .44 Magnum caliber.

The 1892 line of lever-action rifles is one of the products Chiappa Firearms is best known and appreciated for on a global level, and the new Wildlands models are intended to project one of history's most iconic gun designs and of John Moses Browning's most acknowledged accomplishments well into the 21st Century, seamlessly blending their traditional technical layout with a full list of innovations and modern looks.

The Chiappa 92 L.A. Wildlands lever-action rifles are built around fully CNC-machined receivers, and feature 406 mm (16") barrels. Sharing an overall length of 103,1 cm (40.6") long overall and an overall weight of 3,17 kilograms (7 lbs), the 92 L.A. Wildlands rifles by Chiappa are lightweight and handy, meeting the demands and tastes of today's hunting and shooting enthusiasts.

Keeping as faithful as possible to the technical layout of the classic model of 1892, the Chiappa 92 L.A. Wildlands rifles also feature a five-shots magazine tube with a standard, practical side loading port, a top ejection system, and a classic half-cock hammer safety.

The Chiappa 92 L.A. Wildlands line of lever-action rifles counts three variants upon launch:

- **Chiappa 92 L.A. Wildlands** model, offering a full Tactical Grey Cerakote finish on all outer metal surfaces and dark grey laminate furniture. The conic profile barrel comes with a protected 13.5x1LH thread at the muzzle.
- **Chiappa 92 L.A. Wildlands Take Down** model, available with either a conic or octagonal profile barrel, all with a 5/8"-24 muzzle thread; the rifle breaks down easily in two components for easier cleaning and convenient storage or carry.
- **Chiappa 92 L.A. Wildlands Classic** model, with a blued finish on the barrel and feeding port, color case-hardened frame and lever, and oil-finished walnut furniture. The conic profile barrel comes with a protected 13.5x1LH thread at the muzzle.

All variants are issued from factory with a fiber-optic front sight, a rear Skinner peep sight and a Picatinny rail for optics. Sling swivel studs are standard on all models.
