Gelstorm is a low impact skirmish gun that fires at 150fps, it is designed to fit in between Nerf and airsoft. It resembles a toy rather than a regular firearm so that it can be used in back yard areas and not be confused with a regular firearm. The impact is low compared to high level airsoft, it is more enjoyable to younger players who don't wish to be covered in welts. But don't be fooled you definitely know when you're hit. Range is about 100f and the projectiles are made of natural, nontoxic, non-irritating, starch-based material. The Gels are packed in dehydrated form in plastic bags. Hydrating the gels is done by adding water and giving them a couple of hour to hydrate. The cost of gels is about \$5 for 10,000 rounds. Commonly know as Gel Blasters, this new sport is very big in Australia.
